TOTAL RAISED AS OF 8/27/2022 is \$30,738

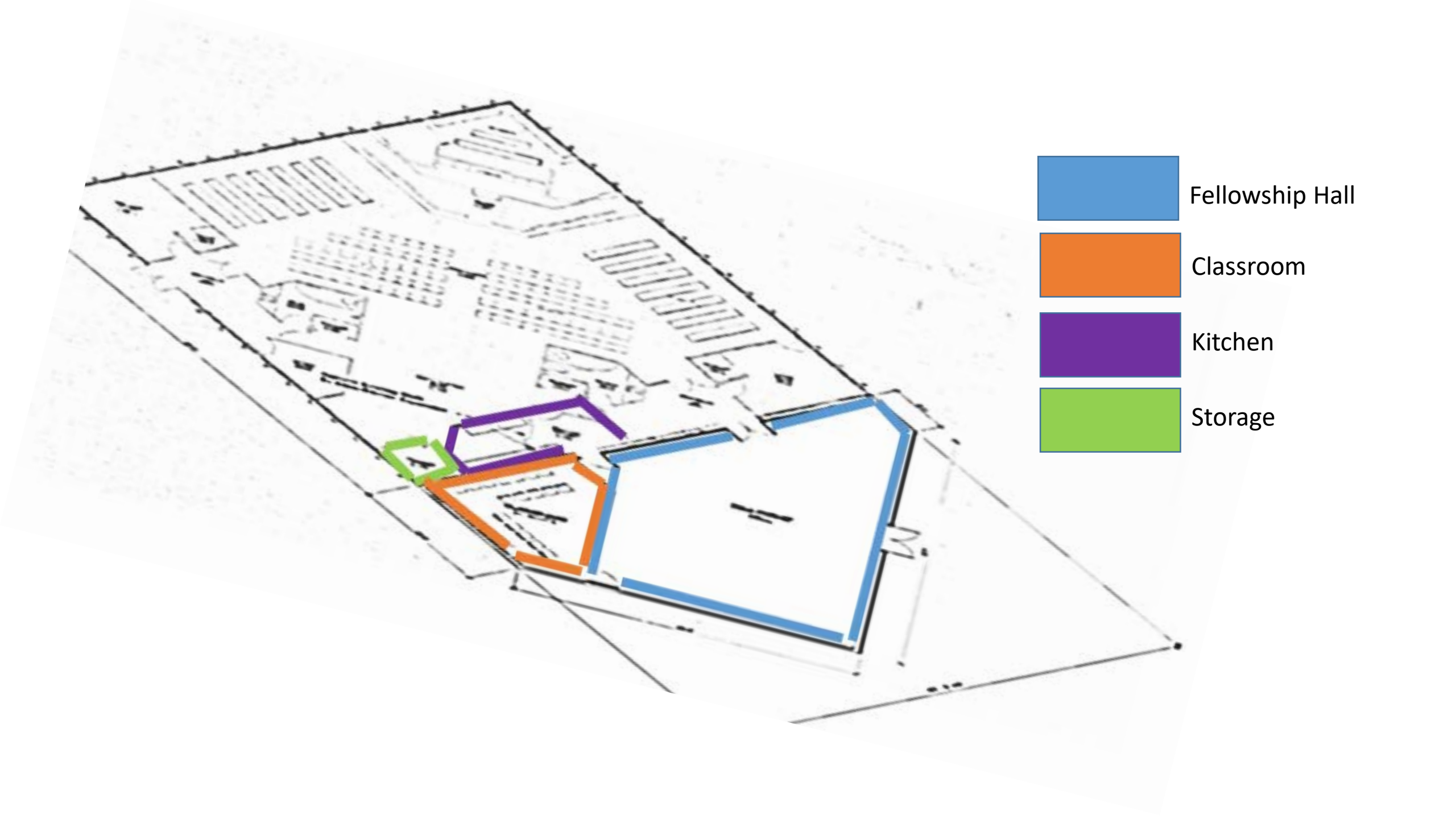
